During this half term we will be learning:

<p>Maths</p> <p>We will learn to count to 5 using concrete objects. We will use counters to help count on, and then begin to count back.</p> <p>We will explore subitising and begin to recognise the number of objects in a group without having to count them individually.</p> <p>We will continue to explore both 2D and 3D shapes.</p>	<p>Phonics</p> <p>We will explore environmental sounds, both indoors and outdoors such as ring of a phone and animal sounds.</p> <p>We will begin to listen out for initial sounds of words e.g. s in sat.</p>	<p>Literacy</p> <p>We will be reading the stories The Gruffalo and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.</p> <p>We will learn new vocabulary and retell these stories.</p> <p>We will explore drawing and writing marks for characters in the story.</p> <p>We will continue to work on recognising and tracing their names.</p>
<p>Foundations of Science</p> <p>We will learn about plants and the children will be able to identify a plant and understand it is a living thing. Will learn about what a plant needs to survive e.g. water, light, food.</p>		<p>Foundations of History</p> <p>We will be learning about our living history, We will explore memories we have and recount these to our friends.
